INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBTATIONS AT ICAR- MGIFRI, PIPRAKOTHI

The celebrations on the 73rd Independence Day were carried out with joy and gaiety at MGIFRI, Piprakothi on 15th Aug.2019.The function began at 11 AM with the unfurling of the *Dharohar Dhwaj*, by the Hon. MP of Motihari and ex- AM Shri Radha Mohan Singh Ji, ex-State Minister Shri Vinod Narayan Jha, Dr B P Bhatt, OSD, ICAR-MGIFRI and in the
