

Field day on 'Popularization of Resource Conservation Technologies' on 31st October 2020 at Buxar under CRP on FM & PF

A field day on 'Popularization of Resource Conservation Technologies' was held at Mahadah village, Buxar under the project, Consortia Research Platform on Farm Mechanization and Precision Farming (CRP on FM & PF) on 31st October, 2020. During the field day, Dr Ramkewal (SMS, KVK Buxar) briefed the farmers about the optimum use of resource conservation technologies, on farm residue management and direct seeding in untilled soil.
