

Training Program on Rice fallow Management

Three days training program conducted on "Rice fallow management by conservation agriculture technology" during 17th to 19th October, 2024 under SCSP of Institute General Fund at village-Kumekela, Block-Pathalgaon, District – Jashpur (Chhattisgarh). The total of 50 farmers (47 male and 3 female) of Kumekela Village participated. The Sarpanch of Kumekela Smt Foolmati Sidar inaugurated the 3 days training program and expressed her gratitude for conducting such a relevant training program for farmers for up scaling their livelihood of SC community under SCSP program by ICAR -RCER, FSRC for HPR, Ranchi.

The farmers were trained with the conservation agriculture technology for rice fallow management and how to increase the cropping intensity and acquainted them with good agricultural practices for cereal, pulses, oilseed crops, cucurbitaceous crops, leguminous vegetables, etc. The farmers were given seeds of chickpea 90kg, lentil, linseed, mustard 80kg each and bitter gourd seeds of 1kg among 50 farmers for cultivating these crops after harvest of paddy for demonstration under the PRAYAS project.
