

Field Day on Livelihood Improvement of SC Farmers through Agricultural Technology Inputs at Saristabad, Patna under SCSP

A Field day on " Demonstration cum distribution of small agricultural inputs among SC farmers for livelihood improvement" was organized by ICAR RCER on 27/05/2022 under SCSP scheme at Saristabad village, Naubatpur , Patna. During this programme agricultural inputs such as 14 Quintal paddy seed (Swarn Shreya, Swarna Samridhi and CR Dhan 909) and 180 no. were distributed among 180 SC farmers. During the programme 180 SC farmers families were participated in which 78 were women participants. During the programme, Dr. Rohan Kumar Raman (Scientist, ICAR-RCER,
