ICAR-Research Complex for Eastern Region, Patna, in conjunction with KAUSHALYA Foundation, handed Knapsack Sprayers to SC farmers (300 no.) in the Nawada district of Bihar on 10-11th September, 2021, as part of the Government of India's Scheduled Castes Component (Scheduled Castes Sub-Plan). During the programme, Scientists from ICAR-RCER, Patna namely Dr. Ved Prakash and Dr. N. Raju Singh along with Mr. Roshan Kumar representative from KAUSHALYA Foundation were present. The benefitted farmers were chosen from 16 villages in Sridala Block and 10 villages in Meskaur Block, Nawada. KAUSHALYA Foundation conducted an inventory survey in the selected block (SC dominated) prior to selecting farmers in order to find the most needy and hardworking farmers.
