## Millet Recipe contest Organized

It also helps in the promotion of diversified agriculture in Rice -Wheat cropping system to minimize the climate risk in crop production as well as cultivation of possible millets unirrigated areas. In this programme, 25 rural women were mobilized in a participatory manner to demonstrate their culinary creativities in making traditional foods using the best possible option from indigenous biodiversity.

All the 25 rural women participated in recipe contest and prepared various food items made up of Bajra. They prepared Bajra Laddu,







Bajra Mugdal, Bajra, Lai, Bajra Namkeen, Bajra Khasta and Bajra Puwa with full zeal and enthusiasm. An evaluation committee of five members comprising School Head master, Sri Ajit

Kumar, Village Sarpanch, Sri Ram Paswan, an elderly non-participating women, Smt Maya devi, farmer, Sri Vinod Kumar Singh and a KVK member, Sri Harigovind, SMS closely monitored and evaluated the millet recipe contest and food items made up of Bajra (pearl millet) *Pennisetumglaucum* (L) prepared by the



contestants. The evaluation was conducted on various parameter keeping in view quality and procedure followed by the contestant during the preparation. The committee members selected three women participants, namely Smt. Saroja Devi for Bajra Mugdal, Maina Devi for Bajra Laddu and Sheela Devi for Bajra Khasta were ranked 1st, 2nd & 3rd respectively. The other participatory women were also facilitated for their efforts in promoting millets in their locality.
