Review Meeting on Progress of Foreign-Aided Projects under NRM Division held at ICAR-RCER, Patna

A review meeting of progress of Foreign-Aided Projects under NRM division of ICAR, New Delhi was held at ICAR Research Complex for Eastern Region, Patna on January 4, 2025 under the chairmanship of Dr. S.K.
