Training programme under SC-SP at ICAR-MGIFRI, Piprakothi, Motihari

A training programme entitled "Advances in goat rearing and meat production" from 7 to 9 January 2020 (Three days) was conducted under SC Sub Plan at ICAR- Mahatma Gandhi Integrated Farming Research Institute, Piprakothi (Motihari). The total number of beneficiary farmers was 25 from Khairimal village of Chakia Block, East Champaran district. The training programme started with registration of farmers followed by kit distribution, lectures, feedback from farmers and certificate distribution. The major topics covered in this programme were selection of goats, housing management of goat, fodder production systems for goat rearing, feeding of goats, breeding and health management of goats. Apart from these, topics on hygienic meat production, scope of goat cum fishery production and various modules for setting up commercial goat farming were also covered. The main focus of training was to improve goat farming through scientific management practices and enhance meat production for better income.
