

Training on Ornamental Fish Culture and Management for Livelihood Improvement of Rural Women organized

A five day training programme on “Ornamental Fish Culture and Management for Livelihood Improvement of Rural Women” is being conducted at ICAR Research Complex for Eastern Region, Patna from 27.06.2016 to 01.07.2016. Shri Radha Mohan Singh Hon’ble Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers’ Welfare, inaugurated the programme. In his address, Hon’ble Minister, stated that a training centre on ornamental fish culture and production has been established recently at ICAR Research Complex for Eastern Region, Patna for imparting training to rural women for their livelihood improvement and empowerment through ornamental fish



farming. The aim of the training programme is to improve the economic condition of rural women through self employment.

Experts from various fields were invited to take classes related to ornamental fish culture. Practical classes are also being carried out to involve them in aquarium construction, setting etc. They are also made aware regarding the schemes and financial assistance that state Government and central government offers for smooth and successful ornamental fish culture activities.

Around 25 farm women from different parts of Bihar participated in the training.
