

Agri-Expo 2018 inaugurated at ICAR RCER, Patna

(Patna, 11th January, 2018)

The ICAR Research Complex for Eastern Region (ICAR-RCER), Patna in collaboration with Professional Agricultural Management Services (PAMS), Gurgaon organized a three days Agri-Expo-2018 at institute campus to showcase the latest science and technological developments in the field of agriculture and allied sectors.

The inaugural function was organized on 11th January, 2018 in which nearly 1000 farmers from different parts of Bihar participated and benefitted from visit to exhibition stalls of public and private sector organizations.

The programme was chaired by Dr BP Bhatt, Director, ICAR-RCER, Patna and Dr Prem Kumar Ji, Honourable
