

ICAR Research Complex Organised One Day Animal Health Camp cum Public awareness campaign in Sipaya, Gopalganj Bihar

One Day Animal Health Camp and public awareness program was organised in association with Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Sipaya, Gopalganj on 31.08.2021. The program's objectives were to bring awareness among farmers about various animal diseases that may have zoonotic potential that can affect the health and production of livestock during flood situation and their long-term consequences. The program was conducted under two institute projects running to determine reproduction in animals and tick-transmitted diseases. Flood affected areas can result in many animal diseases like Leptospirosis and vector-borne diseases. During the one-day program, cattle, buffaloes and goats were clinically examined and tentatively diagnosed for conditions like tick infestation, endoparasitism, mastitis (CMT based diagnosis), infertility, repeat breeding, inappetence, lameness, conjunctivitis, bloat, diarrhoea, etc. These tentatively diagnosed conditions in animals were given on the spot specific and supportive treatment. Blood, ticks, and faecal samples were collected and marked from animals whose conditions required laboratory confirmation. All the animals reporting for the camp were dewormed with broad-spectrum anthelmintic with appropriate dosing. Reproductive problems were given mineral mixture, herbal heat inducers, microminerals and specific managemental measures required. Tick infested animals were given acaricidal drugs and dilution requirements with caution as poison. The importance and methods of tick control in animals and premises were explained to all the farmers. The clinical condition of mastitis was treated using long-acting intramammary infusions. The usefulness of the Dry Coy Therapy after drying off in preventing clinical mastitis after gestation in high yielding lactating animals were communicated to all farmers. During the program, the team also visited the farm of a progressive livestock farmer in the nearby area and provided scientific input and advisory. The animal health camp was carried out by Dr Pankaj Kumar, Senior Scientist, Veterinary Medicine, and Dr M K Tripathi, Scientist of the Division of Livestock and Fisheries management. The program was successfully executed with the support and cooperation of Dr R K Roy, Head and Senior Scientist, KVK Sipaya, Gopalganj and his staff. The event was covered by local newspaper like Danik Jagran.
