

Training Cum Field Day Programme on “Post-flood management strategies”

One day field day cum training program on " *Post-flood management strategies* " was organized on 23rd February, 2021 at village Nima-Belam (Rahika) of Madhubani district, under



the ICAR-IWMI collaborative *Index-Based Flood Insurance (IBFI)* project. The purpose of the training programme was to make aware and sensitize the stakeholders about the post flood agricultural management practices and resource utilization in the recurrent flood-affected areas in Bihar. During the programme discussion were made on scientific cultivation of Makhana in wetlands area, flood water management strategies in post-

flood condition, resource management strategies in flood plain ecosystems and scientific fisheries in Chaur and Maun of North Bihar by the respective resource persons, Dr. I. S. Singh, (principal scientist), Dr. Akram Ahmed (scientist), Dr. Rohan Kumar Raman (scientist) and Sh. S. K. Raut (scientist) from ICAR RCER, Patna.



Further a field day was also organized in that village. Team visited the agricultural fields, ponds and orchards in the village and interacted with farmers of different categories. A brief discussion were also made about the available

resources in that areas and advised them the scientific management practices on agriculture and fisheries practices for increasing their income.
